

## ***Travelling Together***

As from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012, the 13 parishes of Hatherleigh, Meeth, Exbourne, Jacobstowe, Northlew, Okehampton, Belstone, Inwardleigh, Lydford, Sourton, Bridestowe, Germansweek, and Bratton Clovelly are now a Mission Community known as **The Northmoor Team Ministry**. Within that team, we have three full-time clergy, a curate and a part-time consultant. Rev. Stephen Cook is the Team Rector and also has responsibility for Okehampton, Belstone and Inwardleigh. Rev. Ruth Hansford is now the Team Vicar with responsibility for the five parishes at the northern end of the Team, whilst John Davies is the Team Vicar with responsibility for the five parishes at the southern end. Our curate, Rev. David Atallah, who started last year lives in Okehampton. Preb. Anthony Geering, who recently retired as Rector of the Whiddon Team parishes (Chagford et al) helps out with certain aspects of the ministry of the Team for a few hours a week. We are also blessed to have six Readers and numerous lay Worship Leaders in the Team, who make it possible for there to be regular worship in all our churches. On the ground, things may not seem very different, but we hope to support and help each other where we can.

In order to explore our ministry as the Northmoor Team Ministry and get to know each other a bit better, there will be a **Team Retreat Day at the Society of Mary and Martha at Sheldon on March 3<sup>rd</sup>** from 10am-4pm entitled 'Travelling Together'.
