Snow Warden Anyone?

In anticipation of another heavy snow fall this winter, West Devon Council are hoping to recruit a volunteer Snow Warden for Northlew. It would be the Snow Warden's job to recruit other volunteers in the village with the intention of ensuring that the roads within the village are kept clear. It would be the job of the volunteers to grit sections of the road to ensure that people could move about the village and get in and out of their properties. It does not include roads in and out of the village, these would be gritted as normal by the council.

The village would be given 4/5 tons of grit to be stored around the village until needed.
